Please complete the above form, bring it with you when you attend your first church service and give it to an usher as you enter through our doors. If you do not have the form when you arrive, you will be asked to complete one before attending our church service.

There will be signs posted in our vestibule with the following guidelines:

- Per the guidance of the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention), you MUST be wearing a mask, gloves (optional) when entering the church.
- Your mask must be worn the entire time you are in the church.
- For those that are not wearing gloves, your hands will be sanitized with Instant Hand Sanitizer and/or disinfecting wipes which will be disposed of in the trash can provided.
- We will also be doing contactless temperature checks. We are asking those who are ill or displaying symptoms to please stay at home.
- You will be required to maintain social distancing when entering through our doors and during worship service. This would require everyone to maintain six feet of physical separation between each person.
- Those in the same household will be able to sit together.


